
## **Getting to know your telephone**



### **Preprogrammed keys**

Access the various mail services.

Divert your calls to another directory.

Access your personal directory.

Cancel an enquiry call.

Automaticaly redial the last number dialled.


#### **Audio kevs**

### Installing the preprogrammed key label

A printed label is supplied with the terminal. This should be installed between the preprogrammed keys.

- Insert a flat "blade" into the slot.
- Raise the cover.
- Slide the printed label into position.
- Replace the cover.
